Struggle in Our Faith

Read the Mission Statement. Encourage everyone to be involved but to be sure and allow others to participate and to keep their comments on topic.

ICE BREAKER:

Go around the room and ask each person to share something special about this past Easter.

LESSON:

Our Faith in Jesus at times can be challenged. As Pastor Glen mentioned during the Easter service, there are at least three areas that our faith in Jesus wavers at times.

1. His undying love for us
2. His mercy and grace towards us
3. His power within us

All of us have struggled with one or all three of these at some point in time. It is in our belief that Jesus died on the cross for each of us individually that builds our faith in difficult times.

DISCUSSION

1. Have you ever had a time when you believed there was a God but your faith (in His love for you) was weak? What was it like? How did you feel?
2. Did you talk with anyone about your struggle in your faith? Why or why not?

3. Why do we struggle with the love of Jesus at times? For example, why do we find it hard to believe that he loves us no matter what we have done?
4. How should we increase our faith?

PRAY:

Summarize lesson and then ask a few people to pray.
